To All Interested Parties:

Secretary of State Bill Bradbury is responsible for the pre-election review of proposed initiative petitions for compliance with the procedural constitutional requirements established in the Oregon Constitution for initiative petitions. This review will be completed before approving the form of the cover and signature sheets for the purpose of circulating the proposed initiative petition to gather signatures.

The Secretary of State is seeking public input on whether proposed initiative petition (#10), satisfies the procedural constitutional requirements for circulation as a proposed initiative petition. Petition #10 was filed in our office on January 4, 2005, by Bill Sizemore and Grace I. Sizemore, for the General Election of November 7, 2006.

On the reverse side of this letter is a copy of the text of this proposed initiative petition. If you are interested in providing comments on whether the proposed initiative petition meets the procedural constitutional requirements, please write to the secretary at the Elections Division in the State Capitol. Your comments, if any, must be received by the Elections Division no later than January 27, 2005, in order for them to be considered in the review.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OREGON:
THE Oregon Revised Statutes are amended by adding the following
section:**

Section 1. After the effective date of this 2006 Act, neither the state nor any political subdivision of the state or local taxing district shall recognize a public employee union or association as the representative of any public employee(s) for purposes of collective bargaining or resolving of employment related grievances; nor shall any of the aforementioned public entities provide payroll deduction related services for the benefit of a public employee union or association, or negotiate with or enter into a collective bargaining agreement with a public employee union or association. This section shall not affect contractual obligations in effect prior to the effective date of this 2006 Act, but does prohibit subsequent extensions of and changes to contracts in effect before the effective date of this Act. This section supercedes any pre-existing statute with which it conflicts.
